# **CRITERIA FOR 2016 ON-SITE COLLEGE VISITS**

## **ST. JOHN'S UNIVERSITY**

- To be eligible to participate in the St. John's University On-Site Decision Day, students must meet the following academic criteria:
  - **Minimum cumulative GPA of 85**
  - **Minimum standardized test scores:**
    - **SAT test dates prior to March 2016 – Minimum Critical Reading + Math score of 900 of 900, including:**
      - Minimum SAT Critical reading score of 400
      - Minimum SAT Math score of 400
    - **SAT test dates of March 2016 or later – Minimum Evidence Based Reading and Writing + Math score of 980, including:**
      - Minimum SAT Math score of 440
    - **Minimum ACT Composite score of 19 , including:**
      - Minimum ACT Math score of 17
      - Minimum ACT English score of 16
- To receive an admission decision at the On-Site Decision day, eligible students must:
  - **SUBMIT AN ONLINE APPLICATION to St. John's University at least one week prior** to the On-Site Decision Day. Applications may be submitted via Common Application or the SJU Application. Both are available online at [stjohns.edu/apply](http://stjohns.edu/apply)
  - Bring the following documentation to the On-Site appointment:
    - A printed copy of their submitted common application that includes the SJU member page (Common Application only)
    - An official high school transcript
    - Standardized test scores for all test dates (SAT and/or ACT)
    - We do not require a personal essay, letters of recommendation, or resume, though they are encouraged

**Students who choose to apply as a TEST OPTIONAL applicant to St. John's University are NOT eligible to participate in the On-Site Decision Day.**

- Students applying to the following programs are not eligible to participate in the On-Site Decision Day:
    - **Pharmacy, Physician Assistant, Fine Arts, Graphic Design, Illustration, Photography, and Bio-Optometry.**

## ST. JOSEPH'S COLLEGE

- We require that the students complete a paper application or our own SJC Online application prior to meeting with us. You should be receiving paper applications in October, but if you need more, let me know. The online application can be accessed through our website at <http://www.sjcny.edu/applynow>
  - We will waive the \$25 application fee. For our online application, the fee can be waived by entering the promo code LIOSHS on the payment page.
  - We need the completed application, official high school transcripts, ACT/SAT scores.
- -Supplemental documents (essay, letters of recommendation, activities resume) can be submitted on the day of the on-site.
  - We typically make an admissions decision that day.
  - Typically, our admitted students have a solid B average (mid-80s) and at least a 1020 SAT (Math/Critical Reading only) score on the **OLD** test, an 1100 SAT on the **NEW** test, or a 21 ACT. We do however, review all application materials and are interested in students with leadership positions, school involvement, community service, a strong curriculum, and high regents scores.

## Molloy College

1. SAT's should be no less than a 1030 combined on the NEW SAT (ACT Composite Score of 20 or higher)
2. GPA should be no less than an 80 average
3. Students should have a **paper application**, essay, SAT/ACT scores and transcript with them
4. Letters of Recommendation are not required, but if the student has, they should submit
5. Students applying to any music or theatre programs will be accepted to the college contingent upon auditions.
6. Students applying to the Nursing Program may sit for the On-Site.
7. If a student does not meet these requirements, but would like to apply, they may submit their application and we will collect and waive the fee at the On-Site. An evaluation will not be done.

## Adelphi University

“

We are aware that many students may be interested in this event, however due to time constraints we can only review the students who meet the following academic profile:

- **GPA: 83% or 3.0 (out of 4.0) or B unweighted average (or higher)**
- **At least a 1500 on the previous SAT (all three sections) or an 1090 on the redesigned SAT (excluding the optional writing section) or a 22 on the Composite section of the ACT**
  - *We will no longer be requiring the optional writing sections on either the redesigned SAT or the ACT.*

For students who meet the above criteria, the Common Application or Adelphi application **must** be submitted online prior to the event. The following documents should be submitted the day of the event or uploaded **twenty four to forty eight hours prior to the event**:

- Official high school transcript
- Official SAT and/or ACT scores
- One or more recommendation letters
- Essay
- Resume (not mandatory but encouraged)

**Please note:** Students who have the following credentials/interests are unable to receive a decision on the spot due to the need for additional review or requirements:

- International High School records
- Applying for Music, Art, Music/Art Education, Theater, or Dance majors
  - **Students who are interested in the above majors must complete an audition/ portfolio review process to be accepted into the specific department before an admissions decision can be made**

For students who do not meet the academic credentials or need additional review, the admissions staff would be happy to collect their supplemental materials for future review and waive the application fee.

The online process requires that all students interested in participating in the event must submit an online application 24-48 hours prior to the event. The fee does not have to be paid as we will waive it the day of the event (please have students check off the “waive fee” option on the Common Application or Adelphi application and they will be able to submit the application. The fee waiver code to be entered is **ADELPHI**.

## LIU Post

In order for this program to run smoothly we ask that you follow the criteria below:

- Students will need to submit a completed LIU Post application packet to the guidance department by To be Determined (agreed upon date w/ LIU Post Admissions office).
  - A completed application packet includes the following:
    - Completed LIU Post Undergraduate *Admissions Application*
      - Common Application (feewaiver code: ONSITE)
      - LIU Post Application (feewaiver code: ONSITE)
    - Official High School transcript including any senior year grades available
    - All standardized test scores: SAT or ACT (options for official scores)
      - Scores printed on school letterhead
      - Scores printed out of Naviance by a school counselor/administrator not the student
      - Official School Report from College Board
      - Counselor may write scores on transcript and sign next to them

*\*No student copies can be accepted as official.*
    - Letters of recommendation

- Minimum requirements allowed for students participating in Onsite Admissions Event:

High School Average	80 and higher <i>*Students with a GPA below an 80 will automatically be recommended to a second review process*</i>	
SAT (Critical Reading and Math section only); or	1000 and higher (new SAT) or 920 or higher (old SAT) <i>*Students with a test score below 1000 (new) or 920 (old) will automatically be recommended to a second review process*</i>	23 Reading Test Minimum (new SAT) or 420 Critical Reading Section Minimum (old SAT)
ACT	19 and higher <i>*Students with a test score below 19 will automatically be recommended to a second review process*</i>	17 ACT English Minimum

**\*\*For any students who do not meet the above criteria we will waive their application fee if we have a completed application packet and bring their credentials back to the Admissions Office for review by our Admissions Committee. Please provide us the names of the students who fall into this criteria and we will meet with them on a case-by-case basis.**

## MOUNT SAINT MARY COLLEGE

### **WHO SHOULD ATTEND?**

For majors other than those outlined below, typically a student with a solid B and a 900 (critical reading and math) or a 19 ACT (composite) can attend the event. Students below these criteria should be encouraged to apply through the Mount's traditional application process. In many cases, these applicants

will need to submit additional information before a decision is rendered, making us unable to offer an instant admissions decision.

### **What materials are needed to review a student's application?**

We will need a high school transcript and test scores supplied by the Guidance Office (so the documents are verified). In addition, students will need to supply a letter of recommendation from a teacher or guidance counselor. Should students choose to write a short essay, they should answer the following question: evaluate a life-changing event, ethical dilemma or significant experience you've had, and how it impacted you.

### **Special programs – criteria and deadlines**

- **NURSING** – To participate in an Instant Decision, Nursing candidates must have at least an **85 GPA/1000 SAT/ 21 ACT AND successful completion of biology and chemistry** (for courses in-progress, admissions decisions will not be made until first semester grade can be reviewed).
- **BIOLOGY, CHEMISTRY, ENGLISH AND HISTORY WITH ADOLESCENCE EDUCATION 5-YEAR PROGRAM** – **85 GPA/1000, SAT/top 1/3 of their class (must meet two of the three criteria) AND successful completion of biology and chemistry** (for courses in-progress, admissions decisions will not be made until first semester grade can be reviewed).

### **APPLY Online- Prior to event**

- Please encourage all students interested in attending the Instant Decision apply to the Mount prior to the event. Students can apply through our website by visiting [www.msmc.edu/apply](http://www.msmc.edu/apply). Students that don't apply online will be asked to complete a paper application at the event.
- An Admissions File will then be created for the student and when they arrive they can submit remaining components needed to make the decision.
