Dear Parent/Guardian:

The year is moving swiftly by. Believe it or not, the Senior Prom will be here before we know it. I am writing to give you the details of this year's Senior Prom. Our desire is that this event be an appropriate school and class celebration for our Seniors and that we do what we can to make it a safe and enjoyable event for all.

*With this in mind, please plan to drop off your child at the South Lobby on May 29th beginning at 5:00 pm but no later than 5:30 pm. Your child will then be provided coach bus transportation from St. John's to East Wind Caterers (7:00 pm to 12:00 am). The celebration will continue throughout the night with a DJ, live performances, casino games and breakfast to go! At the conclusion of the prom, we will travel by coach bus back to St. John's where you will pick up your child at approximately 12:45 am. Parents may pick up their child at East Wind at the conclusion of the evening. If you choose to do this, please indicate it on the enclosed Permission Slip. **It is important to note that limos and party buses are not permitted, and for safety reasons, students are not permitted to drive to or from St. John's or East Wind for this event.***

On Monday, March 11th, those interested in purchasing tickets to the Senior Prom must sign up in Advisory. All students must be cleared by the Tuition Office and Student Services in order to purchase tickets to the Prom. The list will be checked by both the Business and Student Services Offices. Those who are cleared to purchase tickets will be able to purchase tickets on the sale dates. If a senior is planning to bring underclassmen to the senior prom, the underclassmen must be cleared by the Tuition and Student Services Offices as well.

To facilitate the sale of tickets, students will decide on a "captain" for their table. The captain will be responsible to collect the checks and signed permission forms for each member of his or her group. Please do not send cash and be sure that checks are made payable to St. John the Baptist Diocesan High School. It is important to be aware that all students must be cleared through the Tuition Office and Student Services to purchase tickets. When all checks are collected, the captain will turn them over to me with the signed permission forms, and a list of the names of students and their guests at the table. Tables may vary in size from 8 – 12 people depending on the size of the group.

Please see the attached flyer which contains the required driving information and guest permission form. Thank you for your attention to and assistance with all these details.
