May 31


Saturday Commencement Ceremony at LIU Tilles Center at 2:00PM to 4:00PM. Seating at Tilles Center begins at 1:45PM.

Tickets are required. Except for the graduating senior, each and every person attending (whether they are small children or persons in wheelchairs) will need a ticket. Three (3) tickets will be distributed to each senior the week before graduation along with a formal announcement to each senior who has been cleared for graduation by both the Business Office and the Student Services Office.

Also, for your information and ease, we videotape the entire graduation ceremony. This includes all speeches and the reading of the names. It will be available on the school website after graduation. A professional photographer from Island Photography will take still pictures of each senior receiving their diploma from the Bishop. They will mail you proofs after graduation. You are under no obligation to purchase these pictures, but they are made available for purchase.

We look forward to celebrating these events with you. Thank you for your support and cooperation throughout your student's time here at SJB. Congratulations to all of the members of the Class of 2019!




