Description: Students will spend the week engaging in hands-on activities to better understand how engineers address common problems. They will discover how simple machines such as wedges, screws, and levers help us in our daily lives by completing different tasks such as lifting weights and launching marshmallows. They will then investigate arches, domes, and other functional shapes to determine why they are so strong, culminating in the design and construction of structures that will be taken to the breaking point with our load test.
