

Registration has begun for the SJB Fall Driver Ed Program

The Fall Session is scheduled to begin on November 21 and end on February 6.

Due to the recent provisions made from NYSED regarding the driving portion of NYS approved Driver Education Programs, participants in the program will be offered the following choices for the Fall 2020 Driver Ed Program. Please indicate on your registration form the option of your choice.

- A) This option allows students to receive a "credit" of 4 private driving lessons that they arrange with East Meadow Driving School to conduct at their convenience. The cost is \$425.

- B) This option allows the students to complete the driving portion of the program via "parental supervision". East Meadow Driving School will provide the necessary guidance and curriculum for the parents to document the completion of the program. The driving school then issues the students an in-car grade, as they would normally. The cost is \$575.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

All Students will attend the lecture portion of the program remotely.

All remote lecture lessons must be completed on time. Any missing work will result in the student failing the course.

Students must be at least 16 years old. Students must also acquire a NY State Learner's Permit prior to registering. Students from any school may register for the program.

If a student is scheduled for classes, a \$50 fee will be charged for any withdrawal request made after November 18, 2020. No refund will be authorized after November 28, 2020.

By Saint Johns the Baptist regulations, all absences must be made up. It is the student's responsibility to arrange with, and obtain prior approval from the lecture instructor to proceed with any make-up assignments. There are no "excused" absences.
