Dear Parents and Guardians of Students in Grades 9, 10, 11:

At this time, we would like to share with you very important information to assist in the closure of this unprecedented school year.

- **Tuesday, June 9 - The last virtual class for all Freshmen, Sophomores, and Juniors**

The following days are to be used to work independently, prepare and finalize all Assessments and Projects.

- **Friday, June 12 – Study Day**
- **Friday, June 19 – Final Assessments and Projects to be submitted to the student’s respective teachers by 3:00 p.m.**

***\*Parents/Guardians are asked to please be sure that your child submits required Assessments and Projects by 3:00 p.m. on June 19, 2020 to the student’s respective teacher. Please note that all Final Written Assessments will be completed at home and submitted as directed by the student’s teacher.***

**Locker Clean Out for All Grades – Please follow the directives below and respective schedule for each individual grade level:**

- Please bring large bag(s) and backpacks to carry items
- Please remember to bring your locker combination with you
- Students must wear gloves and mask
- Park in the designated parking area in the parking lot
- Only Student exits car and goes to the designated markings (which are 6 ft apart) near front entrance of the school building.
- Mr. McKeivitt, the Dean, will then permit 6 students at a time to enter the building to clean out their lockers.
- When the student has emptied his or her locker, they are to exit the building by way of the doors on the 1<sup>st</sup> Floor.
- Internal staff will advise Mr. McKeivitt when another student may enter the building.
- Any issues that arise in the school building during this clean-out should be directed to Mrs. Gohn who will be in the front of the elevators on the 1<sup>st</sup> Floor.
- If a student chooses not to clean out his or her locker, which is acceptable, our maintenance staff will pack all of the items in the locker, label the bag with the student’s name, and the student will be contacted via email on another pick-up day that will be scheduled.
- Exit the building – PLEASE DO NOT CONGREGATE IN THE SCHOOL PARKING LOT OR ANY OTHER LOCAL AREA FOR EVERYONE’S SAFETY.

Note: After locker clean-out each day, the areas used will be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized.


- **Friday, June 12 – Baccalaureate Mass (Virtual) 7:00 p.m.**
