Acceptable:

Types of Service: DIRECT SERVICE TO THE VULNERABLE: Service where you are in close contact with those in need

INDIRECT SERVICE: Service where your activity contributes to an important cause (such as curing cancer, making your community a better place)

All activities must be done for charity/non-profit

Acceptable Types of Service Continued:

Unacceptable:

Service that you should be doing anyway or any volunteering that is done for a <u>for-profit</u>

business will not qualify as

Christian Witness.

- Raking your own or your neighbor's leaves
- Filing papers or other work for the family business or any business (e.g., helping at a dance studio)
- Babysitting
- Tutoring your younger sibling or cousin/neighbor
- Activities you are required to perform for NHS, Club, Sport or Class.
- •Anything against Catholic Teaching

Christian Witness Requirements -

- 5 hours each quarter (20 hours per year, June 2022-June 2023)
- Christian Witness accounts for 5% of your overall grade each quarter.
