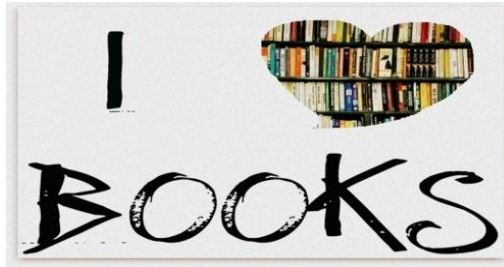


BOOK BUZZ



Your summer reading book at a glance! The objective of this assignment is to demonstrate an understanding of the book by providing you the opportunity to choose the literary aspects of it that were significant in deriving meaning from the story.

1. *Title(italicize)* Author
2. A brief summary of the book - 2 or 3 **powerful** sentences.
3. **What I like/love about the book.**
I loved this book because.....
4. **How this book challenged me.**
I struggled with this book because.....
5. **Three theme words** present in this work
A theme is a central message or insight into life revealed through a literary work.)
6. **Three compelling quotes from the book.**
These should be lines that are meaningful to the story, but can be just as meaningful to someone who has not read the story. These are quotes you might see on a t-shirt, or bumpersticker, or magnet. Each quote should follow the rule of ICE:
introduce - what's going on in the book when these words are stated
cite - provide the quote in quotation marks followed by the author last name and page number in parentheses EX: "It was the best of times ..." (Dickens 1)
explain - what does this quote mean, and why is it important?
7. Each of the above steps, ICE, should be presented in a separate sentence, **on the back of your BB, or on a 2nd page, the lines themselves will appear on the front.**
8. **Include multiple images (either one you find or one you create) that provides a visual depiction of the book.**

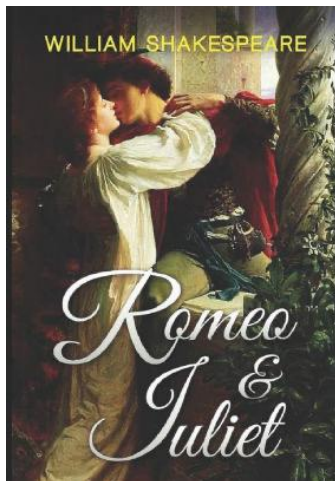

*The **Tragedy** of Romeo and Juliet -William Shakespeare*

Romeo and Juliet tells the story of a young boy and girl who fall in love, but come from two different families who despise each other, therefore unable to be together. Being separated from each other causes them so much pain, that they both take their own lives. The cost of the family feud was the death of the two "star crossed lovers."



Love

"With love's light wings did I o'erperch these walls, for stony limits cannot hold love out" -Romeo

I liked this play because it demonstrates the lengths people will go to for love. Romeo and Juliet took their own lives because they could not live without one another.

Conflict

"This day's black fate on more days doth depend. This but begins the woe others must end" -Romeo

I struggled with this play because of the language. It was hard to follow along and understand at times.

Violence

"Death, that hath ta'en her hence to make me wail, ties up my tongue and will not let me speak" -Lord Capulet



I- Juliet is on her balcony and Romeo is on the ground underneath. At first Juliet does not realize Romeo is there, but when she does, she tells him if her family finds out he is there he will be killed.

C- "With love's light wings did I o'erperch these walls, for stony limits cannot hold love out" (Shakespeare).

E- This quote is saying that nothing can keep you from reaching love, even something as stone walls. It is also saying that love will make you do things that might seem impossible. This line is important because it shows that nothing will hold Romeo back from being with Juliet.

I- Juliet drinks the drink that Friar Lawrence gave her, and the Capulet family now thinks she is dead. They are all grieving over her "death."

C- "Death, that hath ta'en her hence to make me wail, ties up my tongue and will not let me speak" (Shakespeare).

E- Lord Capulet is saying that death had taken Juliet, and he is so distraught he cannot even speak. This line is important because it tells what the loss of a loved one can do to someone.

I- Tybalt and Mercutio fight, and when Romeo intervenes, Mercutio stabs Tybalt. Benvolio and Mercutio leave, but then Benvolio comes back to tell Romeo that Mercutio has died.

C- "This day's black fate on more days doth depend. This but begins the woe others must end" (Shakespeare).

E- This line means the future will be affected by the events in the present moment. This is important because it makes you think about your actions before you do them, and how they can affect your future.
